Supplemental Award for Undergraduate Women



Financial Aid for Service and Young Women's Ministries are collaborating to offer women participating in the National Presbyterian College Scholarship and Student Opportunity Scholarship a chance to apply for an additional \$1,000 supplemental award sponsored by Young Women's Ministries.

Young Women's Ministries mission states: "We are young women connected by our belief in God, seeking a Christian faith that empowers women." Reflecting on this mission, interested students should prepare a response, in 300-500 words, to each of the following questions:

Eligibility

National Presbyterian College Scholarship or Student Opportunity Scholarship women, awarded in 2019-20, with remaining need.

Awards

No more than six (6) \$1,000 awards, supplemental to the National Presbyterian College Scholarship or Student Opportunity Scholarship conveyed supplemental to the maximum award for each program and without decreasing amounts the student may be eligible to receive in future years.

1. **How has your faith empowered you? How has this shaped your studies and/or vocational choices?**
2. **How have you worked for the empowerment of women during your lifetime, and in what ways do you plan to do so in the future?**

To be considered for the supplemental award, students will prepare a response to both questions.

The responses must be received by July 18. Submissions should be prepared on plain white paper, double spaced, with no photographs embedded in the document. Young Women's Leadership Development will select up to six women for awards to be announced on August 1. All award disbursements will be made through the college or university recorded in your National Presbyterian College Scholarship or Student Opportunity Scholarship application, divided by term according to the instructions provided by the school.

Financial Aid for Service will receive submissions, and present them to our ministry partner for consideration, provide selected students with award notifications, and convey awards to schools.

Young Women's Ministries is charged with the responsibility of selecting students for award and provides the funding to support the award.
