March 11–23, 2019

What are the roots of nearly 1 million Tutsi's being murdered in Rwanda in 1994? How was the Church complicit? What reconciliation work is still needed today? The answers to these and other questions provide insights into contexts of conflict today.

Ukraine and Russia: Peacemaking on the Front Line

April 22–May 6, 2019

This seminar explores the conflict in Eastern Ukraine from our partners' perspective in Ukraine and Russia. It includes a consultation in Poland, where Ukrainians and Russians will dialogue on neutral ground about peacemaking and reconciliation in the context of the conflict.

Central American Migrant Trails: Exploring the Journeys to and from the United States and Why We Must Act

February 17-28, 2020

This is an opportunity to understand firsthand the immigration context we are facing in the US and why our Central American brothers and sisters take the risk of embarking on this dangerous journey. We will explore other potential and actual consequences of US policies, such as mass deportation, and how that is impacting the lives of the returned migrants, their families, communities and nations. The seminar will take us to Guatemala, El Salvador, and Honduras.




Philippines and Hong Kong: Root Causes and Current Challenges of Forced Migration and Labor Trafficking
