For the past 20 years the WPC has examined challenging concepts of privilege and oppression and offers solution and team building strategies to work towards a more equitable world. WPC is a conference designed to examine issues of privilege beyond skin color. WPC is open to everyone and invites diverse perspectives to provide a comprehensive look at issues of privilege including: race, gender, sexuality, class, disability, etc.

To be considered for this award students must respond to the below prompts by February 17, 2020.

Interested students should prepare a response, in 300-500 words, to each of the following questions:

- 1. Tell the committee about a bias you hold or have held in the past that you had to acknowledge and unpack. What was hard about that experience? How did that work change you?**
- 2. What skill do you hope to gain or hone at the White Privilege Conference?**

Submissions should be prepared on plain white paper, double spaced, with no photographs embedded in the document.

Financial Aid for Service will receive submissions and present them to the selection committee for consideration. The selection committee will select up to ten students for award. Awards will be announced by February 21st.

Award will be sent out upon completion by the awardee of a grant agreement, w-9 and direct deposit form. Financial Aid for Service will register on behalf of the awardee. The awardee is responsible for booking their travel and making their own hotel arrangements.
