



INVESTING FINANCIALLY IN A NEW WORSHIPING COMMUNITY

Provide a Grant for a Worshiping Community \$25,000

Investment to match a grant from the Presbyterian Mission Agency
Two grants of up to \$25,000 each are available from the Presbyterian Mission Agency usually during the second to fourth years of a worshiping community. Each grant requires a local match.

Provide an Apprenticeship for a Leader \$6,000

Includes mentoring and oversight, training in cohort and attendance at 1001 national conference. Apprenticeships can be served over a 2-, 10- or 12-month time period.

Provide Coaching for a Leader \$3,000

Includes site visit, coaching contract, annual training conference and staff travel.

Provide an Assessment for a Leader \$1,000

Includes diagnostic tools, lodging, meals and staff travel.

Provide Training for Community Leaders (per person) \$1,000

Includes curriculum and trainer, lodging, meals and staff travel

Launch a Community \$68,000

Potential costs to establish one new worshiping community during a 2- to 3-year launch*

- Matching investment grants (2) \$50,000
- Leader apprenticeship \$6,000
- Leader coaching (two years) \$6,000
- Leader team training (5 on team) \$5,000
- Leader assessment \$1,000

Financial investment for one NWC \$68,000

Such an investment could leverage up to an additional \$62,000 from the Presbyterian Mission Agency.

*Costs could be more or less, depending on the level of direct support provided by the presbytery
