About the Grant

The Wolf-Schick Maintenance Grant provides support for the construction of needed buildings such as dormitories, school buildings, libraries, including equipment for the same.

The program will support an award up to \$20,000, Presbyterian Mission Agency seeks proposals from Warren Wilson College and Westminster (Salt Lake, UT) first.

If no proposals are forthcoming, we will consider proposals from any institution defined as a Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) related college, university, or secondary school by the General Assembly. The deadline for this program is the first Friday in June for Warren Wilson College and Westminster College (UT), and thereafter on the first Friday in September and December on a funds available basis.

When the program funding is fully committed for the year, we will close our application portal for Wolf-Schick and re-open by the second Monday in February.

If awarded, the grant activity must be completed within 24 months of award.

On a funds available basis, the Wolf-Schick Grant may also be used to support technology purchases outside the scope of Teaching the Bible Grant and the John C. Martin Award. The application is hosted Microsoft Forms. Its purpose is to collect information the grant administration team needs. If you prefer to provide the details of your proposal and budget in the form of a document, please follow the prompts in the application. Proposals can be uploaded or emailed to finaid@pcusa.org to complete your grant request.

Before you start the application be prepared to:

- Identify a project leader, or primary contact.
- Describe the project in one or two sentences.
- Provide a start and end date for the project.

Deadline: Quarterly (1st Friday in June)

Funds available: September, December

Complete proposals are considered by a selection committee in the deadline month with award announcements made at the end of the month.

2022 Request for Proposal

The Presbyterian Mission Agency seeks proposals for construction of needed buildings such as dormitories, school buildings, libraries, hospitals, including equipment for the same.

The selection committee will consider proposals for:

- Shovel-ready new construction, renovation, or maintenance projects.
- Acquisitions for libraries.
- Equipment used on campus to teach or support student life.
- Improvements to the chapel.

On a funds available basis, Wolf-Schick may be used to replace or supplement portions of Teaching the Bible Grant and Martin Award proposals for the purchase of equipment, services, and software outside the scope of the Bible Grant programs.

Proposal Guidelines

Proposals should be no more than 10 typewritten pages.

Cover Letter/Endorsement

Provide a letter from the head of school, department, or development office, or designee indicating the institution's support for the proposal, and commitment to acting on the proposal if selected.

Executive Summary

Briefly describe what the grant would be used to create or replace. Explain how the proposed use will address the mission of the college or university and the donor's intention to support Presbyterian related schools, colleges, and universities.

Proposal Details

Provide details about the program proposed. Please address the following questions, if applicable:

- What is the principal focus of the proposal?
- What outcomes are sought from this use?
- Is this a limited activity, or will it be continued if the pilot is successful?

New Project(s)

Provide a summary of the new project(s).

- Will students benefit from the program? How?
- Will students participate? How?
- What is the timeline from implementation to completion?

Budget

The total cost of the project and how the funding will be used.

Disbursement Schedule

Wolf-Schick Maintenance Grants are paid in one payment. Please feel free to propose a disbursement schedule in your proposal.
