

We Believe Workshop objectives

Jesus Washes the Disciples' Feet

John 13:1-15

The **Art Workshop** explores John 13:1-15 through creative art experiences.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Hear the story of Jesus washing his disciples' feet.
- Make a "footprint welcome mat."
- Wash someone's feet.
- Have their feet washed.

The **Audiovisual Workshop** explores John 13:1-15 through audiovisual media that is heard, viewed, or made.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Describe a "winner" by choosing from a list of adjectives.
- Hear and see the story of Jesus washing the disciples' feet from a Bible or Bible storybook and from *Animated Stories from the New Testament: The Greatest Is the Least* DVD.
- Describe a "Jesus follower" by choosing from a list of adjectives.
- Choose one "Jesus follower" adjective to practice.

The **Computer Workshop** explores John 13:1-15 using computers. Sometimes computers are used to tell the story and sometimes they are used to respond to it.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Read or hear the story of how Jesus washed the feet of the disciples and taught them to serve others.
- Observe different images of footwashing.
- Respond to the story of the footwashing using *Kid Pix Studio Deluxe 4.0* or *Microsoft Paint* program.

The **Drama/Storytelling Workshop** explores John 13:1-15 by retelling the story in ways that help children remember it.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Hear the story of Jesus washing the disciples' feet.
- Retell the story using foot puppets.
- Act like a servant.

The **Games and Puzzles Workshop** explores John 13:1-15 by having children play biblically related games or puzzles.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Play the "Simon Peter Says" game (similar to "Simon Says").
- Practice finding and reading the Scripture passage.
- Play "Service Scavenger Hunt."
- Say thank you to those who serve in Jesus' name.

The Music and Worship Workshop explores John 13:1-15 through music and makes the connection to worship in PC(USA) congregations.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Hear, read, and reenact the story of Jesus washing the disciples' feet.
- Make a stole as a reminder of the footwashing.
- Learn the chorus of the hymn "Jesu, Jesu."

The Bonus: Discipleship Workshop explores John 13:1-15 with activities that help children learn how to follow Jesus.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Make "footprints" using their hands.
- Have their hands washed by someone and wash someone else's hands.
- Discuss what it means to be a disciple.
- Identify disciples in the church.
- Make a gift and a card for a disciple.
