We Believe Workshop objectives

Road To Emmaus

The Art Workshop explores Luke 24:13-35 through creative art experiences. Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Consider how God is revealed all around us.
- Hear and tell the story of the road to Emmaus.
- Learn about a labyrinth and make a labyrinth out of clay.

The Audiovisual Workshop explores Luke 24:13-35 through audiovisual media that is heard, viewed or made.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Retell the story of the road to Emmaus.
- Begin to see ways to welcome others and understand hospitality.
- Identify ways to recognize the living Christ in our lives today.

The Computer Workshop explores Luke 24:13-35 using computers. Sometimes computers are used to tell the story, and sometimes they are used to respond to it.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Hear the story of Jesus' appearance to two disciples after the resurrection.
- Consider ways we can show hospitality and welcome "the stranger" at church.
- Identify ways we can get to know Jesus today.
- Use Kid Pix Studio Deluxe, 3rd edition (younger children) and Discovery's Life of Christ software (older children).

The Drama/Storytelling Workshop explores Luke 24:13-35 by retelling the story in ways that help children remember it.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Do recognition activities with prepared guessing stations. Children will use their senses to guess what they touch, hear, and/or smell.
- Hear the story from a storyteller pretending to be Cleopas.
- Respond to recognizing Jesus.

The Games and Puzzles Workshop explores Luke 24:13-35 by having children play biblically related games or puzzles.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Find Luke 24:13-35 in their Bibles (older children).
- Retell the story of the road to Emmaus.
- Consider what it means to show hospitality; consider ways to show hospitality.
- Play close attention to their environment by using magnifying glasses and binoculars and by taking a walk around their church or neighborhood.

The Music and Worship Workshop explores Luke 24:13-35 through music and makes the connection to worship in PC(USA) congregations.

Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Retell the story of the Emmaus road appearance of Jesus.
- Learn to sing a round.
- Sing a prayer.
- Sing the song "Be Known to Us in the Breaking Bread" and think of things we do because Jesus lives in our hearts.

The Bonus: Cooking Workshop explores Luke 24:13-35 through cooking. Objectives of the Workshop

The children will have the opportunity to:

- Bake "Emmaus Honey Wheat Bread" to take home and share with family members, neighbors or friends.
- Read or hear Luke 24:13-35.
- Ponder questions about the story.
- Consider how we may sense the presence of Christ in surprising places.
